Maintain a disaster kit which should include:

First Aid Kit, corded, non-electric telephone, Rubber/latex gloves, two (2) heavy duty utility flashlights with fully charged batteries, rolls of plastic sheeting, paper towels, duct tape, and scissors. This kit will be located behind the public service desk or hallway closet.

- 1. Move material higher on shelves, OR
- 2. Move material to another location: Dinsmore Firehouse, Old Post Road

BUILDING EVACUATION:

Assist all present to leave the building as soon as it is obvious remaining may be a health hazard. Assist those with disabilities by asking the best way to help. Get the attention of a person with a hearing disability by touch, gesture and/or pointing. Do not grasp a visually impaired person by the arm. Ask if they need your arm as they exit.
